

Discipline Policy

Parents,

We are required by the Department of Children and Families to provide parents with a written discipline policy. Please sign this form and return to front office.

Our program will insure that age appropriate, constructive disciplinary practices are used for your child. This care will allow the child time to look over his or her behavior. We will encourage children to choose alternatives to improve behavior. To insure a safe and successful program, discipline is a must. We

welcome the ideas of parents; please feel free to share them with us. The following steps will be used for behavior modification: 1st Children will be corrected and asked to change their behavior 2nd Children will be re-directed from situation. 3rd Children will be placed in "Thinking chair" according to age. 4th Parents will be contacted if behavior is not corrected. 5th Children shall not be subjected to discipline which is severe, humiliating, or frightening. 6th Discipline shall not be associated with food, rest, or toileting or playground time. 7th Spanking or any other form of physical punishment is prohibited. 8th Children may not be denied active play as a consequence of misbehavior. have received in writing the disciplinary practices used by this child care facility.
